## Ibero-Americana Pragensia

The *Ibero-Americana Pragensia* annual is an academic publication published since 1967 by Charles University. It has acquired considerable prestige and since the 1990s has been annotated by one of the most famous bibliographical journals *Revista Interamericana de Bibliografía*, published by the Organization of the American States. It was the first academic periodical in Central and Eastern Europe published in Spanish. It presents mainly essays in history, literary science and linguistics, and secondly also in ethnology, arts history, philosophy and other humanities fields. The section titled “Materials” presents sources on the relations of Central Europe with Spanish and Portuguese speaking regions.
